Did you know the IRS receives roughly 1,000,000 applications for tax exempt status each year? They gave us that number in 2018, which means 1M new entities join the small businesses market each year. Yet they tend to be denied access to Small Business Assets and Loan Products only because they are classified as tax exempt.

The only number that's important to know is this... at least 1,000,000 new tax-exempt businesses are formed every year.

The *501c StartUp-2-SmallBiz Xchange (SB2SB™)* is a series of Podcast that introduce 501c startups & 501c small businesses to the markets they hope to serve, their 501c Small Biz Peers. It also connects them to *For-Profit Small Businesses* we hope will become suppliers to & customers of our 501c Startup/Tax-Exempt Small Biz Stakeholders.

The *501c Startup & Small Business Collective* (*501cSBC*)<sup>™</sup> are 501c Startups, Entrepreneurs, & Tax-Exempt Small Business Members of our Natl Chamber & ATESE Founders Association. They meet virtually and in weekly Podcasts to ID business issues & discuss how Federal, State, and Local politics & legislation *impact the business side* of organization that adversely effect their tax-exempt purpose so The Foundation and its parent, The Competence Group, LLC can develop interim resources and permanent work-around solutions.

These Small Business are Stakeholders from the 501c idea-formation-incubator stage well into operation as a young tax-exempt small business following the IRS approval of their 501c status.

Yeah, you read that right — *Tax-Exempt Startups Are Small Businesses*! And we're making sure they treated that way. The *National Chamber Membership of 501c Small Businesses (NCTSB)* and the "*Association of Tax Exempt Startups & Entrepreneurs (ATESE)™* for 501c Founders, are sister orgs. Each was established to promote recognition of 501c Startups as Small Business entities, to collect data on exclusionary practices, connect them with the business, executive level learning, and financial assets they require to succeed and the *PBC™* and *SB2SB™ Podcast* are examples of how we're getting it done. The Collective Articulates their issues so we can develop solutions.

The **PBC**™ will be the 501c startup destination for connecting to Small Business Assets and building peer 501c Small Business relationships.
